WHEREAS, Arizona Revised Statute 13-3624 A. requires the presiding judge of the superior court to make available on a rotating basis a judge, justice of the peace, magistrate or commissioner for the issuance of emergency telephonic orders of protection;

IT IS ORDERED that the Superior Court Administrator, or in the alternative, the Limited Jurisdiction Court Administrator prepare and provide a list of judges, magistrates or commissioners who shall be available during the hours the courts are normally closed for business for the telephonic issuance of emergency orders of protection. The lists of available judges shall be disseminated to local law enforcement agencies and whenever updated or changed, a copy shall be sent to all appropriate law enforcement agencies.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all information identifying judges, magistrates, and commissioners, their names, addresses and phone numbers shall remain confidential and shall only be used in connection with the provisions of Arizona Revised Statute 13-3624.
